Report on CSR and sustainable Development for January - 2024 to March-2024

Health Care Services

The Corporation runs a Health Centre in the R&R Mankhurd in association with "Doctors for you", where various health care services are provided to the local public at highly subsidized cost.

MRVC Health Centre at Lallubhai Compound, Mankhurd is functional since 2013. The services are provided at the health centres on daily basis, like general OPD, dental OPD, Tuberculosis treatment, Immunization, Growth monitoring OPD, family planning and maternal & child health services. In the health centre at Lallubhai compound, specialized services i.e. physiotherapy and disability rehabilitation, Gynecology clinic, Eye clinic and Skin disease, Psychiatric, heart ailment treatment etc. are also provided. The OPD services are backed up by laboratory services and pharmacy. With the opening of this health centre, quality health services are easily accessible and affordable to residents of these PAP resettlement colonies and nearby slum areas. The Health Centre has been providing health care services to more than 7.5 lakh persons since its inception.

B. Maternal and Child Health Care:

• Antenatal care to Pregnant Women:

Continuum of care approach is used to provide maternal and child health services at our center which includes services for – reproductive age women, maternal (Antenatal care for pregnant women), newborn care, child health services (immunization). All the female reproductive issues like Pelvic Inflammatory disease, infertility, reproductive tract infections are managed by the Gynecologist at the health centre which runs twice a week.

Immunization services:

Immunization services are provided at both Centre and on field through outreach services. Routine Immunization is carried at our center twice a week on Monday and Thursday, while outreach immunization on field is carried out on daily basis for under five years age of children. Vaccination is given against TB, Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus, Hemophilus influenzae B, Hepatitis B, Polio, Rotavirus, Measles, Rubella.

Deworming against protozoal infection-:

Soil Transmitted infections caused by a group of parasites such as worms/hookworm is among the most common infections in children. Those living in poverty are most vulnerable to this infection which can impair their nutrient intake, digestion and absorption causing infectious diarrhea. De worming against protozoal infection is supplemented with immunization.

Vitamin A Supplementation to prevent blindness and infections in children:

Vitamin A deficiency can cause visual impairment like night blindness and August increase risk of infection in children. Vitamin A Deficiency affects about 190 million preschool age children (as per WHO e-library of Evidence for Nutrition Actions). Vitamin A is supplemented with the immunization.

• <u>Tuberculosis</u>:

Activities at the centre for Tuberculosis.

 Home environment: Importance of environment (such as space, ventilation and overcrowding) in the prevention of the spread of TB. Further, DOTS provider explains the importance of adherence to treatment and completing the complete course of AKT. They also emphasize the problem associated with irregular treatment and defaulter.

2. Awareness among family members:

The family members are educated about mode of TB transmission, precaution to be taken to prevent the spread of disease and Importance of timely intake of medicines and development of drug resistance due to incomplete and inadequate treatment. Family members were also advised to visit the health center in case of symptoms such as Cough (>2Weeks), Fever and decreased appetite.

• GENERAL HEALTH CHECK UP CAMP AT SHANKAR NAGAR SLUM NO 127 (GOVANDI):

A health check up camp was conducted at Shivaji Nagar Rafique Nagar Slum No 15 – Govandi on 12th January 2024. A free medical health camp was held for all the slum people wherein free sugar test, hemoglobin test, blood pressure test, etc., followed by consultation of Doctor was done and free of cost medicines were also distributed in this camp. This camp was very much beneficial for the people of slums located near the Dumping Area.





The Hygiene Kit consisted of Brush, Colgate, Sanitary Pads, Nail Cutter, Hand wash, Sanitizer and In First Aid Kit Consisted of ANTISPECTIC Liquid, Dettol, Cotton Roll, Bandage, Beta dine Cream.
